



Junior Certificate Students and E8 Forms

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

On Wednesday 21st February, third year students will be asked to fill out their E8 Forms.

These forms are pre-printed by the State Exams Commission and contain candidate name, exam number, pps no., date of birth, list of junior certificate subjects being taken by the individual, the level of paper in Irish, English and Maths. In addition, if a candidate is taking an additional subject outside of school there is a space to include the subject for examination.

Once the candidate has checked that the information on their E8 form is correct, they are asked to sign and date the form.

A pdf of the instructions for candidates will accompany this post on our school website and will also be published to the Third Year Teams page.

The purpose of this form is to aid the State Exams Commission in the final preparation for State Exams in June, e.g. assigning candidates to centres, appointment of superintendents, packing of examination papers etc.

All third years must present to school on this day as the forms will be posted to the SEC on Wednesday afternoon to meet the deadline for submission set by the SEC.

Note in respect of levels for Irish, English and Maths. The level for the subject submitted to the SEC on the E8 form is the level of exam paper that the candidate must sit in June. Junior Certificate students are not allowed to change their levels on the day of the exam. This is a facility only offered to Leaving Certificate students.
